

VERY IMPORTANT: To replace your existing feeder with this new one:

Bait & Switch... Hang the old feeder in its original location but make sure it's totally *EMPTY*. Hang the new feeder next to it, *FILLED* and ready for them to check out. Also use this method if you're planning to continue using your old feeder.

Patience is key! Most switch in a couple days but some flocks of hummingbirds can take weeks to switch to a new feeder.

Cleaning: Your feeder is **diswasher safe!** To hand wash, fill the sink with warm water, add a touch of vinegar, slosh the feeder and rinse well. If you decide to use dish soap, be sure to rinse **WELL** with **COLD** water. Yes, **COLD** water.

For success feeding hummingbirds, and to keep your hummingbirds safe, **PLEASE** change the nectar (sugar water mix) every 3 to 4 days. The ratio for nectar is 4 parts water to 1 part sugar.

More about the nectar: Hummingbirds prefer **PURE, WHITE CANE** sugar. Other types of sugar can 'gel' in your feeder. Also, hummingbirds shouldn't have the impurities that are in organic or "raw" sugar. These impurities will also cause your nectar to 'sour' faster.

NEVER EVER use red food color in your nectar. It's very bad for hummingbirds!

To avoid insect invasions: Fill the center ant moat with clean water. Also, take care not to slosh nectar on the outside of the feeder when filling & hanging.

Your Lil Sweetie or Hum Sweet Hum feeder can make this small part of your life stress free. We can't help you with the rest of the stress in your life but watching the hummingbirds at your new feeder can be a pleasant avoidance.

Guarantee: We want you and your family to enjoy feeding hummingbirds for generations so we've made the best feeder we possibly can. It is extremely tough and UV stable. If there are ever any failures due to defects in manufacturing or workmanship, we will replace any defective part. Don't forget to include your Lil Sweetie (or Hum Sweet Hum) feeder in your will because it will probably still be in great shape long after you're gone.

These feeders were extensively field tested and are overwhelmingly accepted by hummingbirds. Because we can't control variables with humans, misuse and environments we cannot guarantee acceptance of all hummingbirds so we do not accept returns because your hummingbirds won't use the feeder.

Effortless Assembly:

Gently insert the hanger into the center hole of the feeder bowl while slightly turning the hanger clockwise. The hanger will easily drop into place.

To Remove the Hanger:

Hold the feeder, taking the weight off the hanger. *Gently* turn the hanger counterclockwise, only about a quarter turn, while gently pulling it up and out. Forcing it won't do any good and it'll just make it more difficult. So just relax and remove the hanger.

Incredibly Easy Fill & Mix Feature:

- 1) Insert the two dividers into adjacent slots in the bowl.
- 2) Fill the smallest area between the 2 dividers with pure, white cane sugar, to the top of the dividers. Then, pull out ONE of the dividers.
- 3) Pour HOT water directly into the sugar, up to the top of the divider. Remove that remaining divider.
- 4) Put the colored lid on and gently agitate the feeder until the sugar is dissolved. 'Twirling' as it sits flat on the counter works best.
- 5) Remove the lid to cool.
- 3) Replace the lid and fill the **Center Ant Moat** with clean water.
